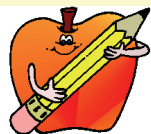

RESPECT LIFE

Today's readings: In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us, "Thus it will be for all who store up treasure for themselves but are not rich in what matters to God." And what is it that matters to God? Today's second reading answers the question. What matters to God is that we become like him, that we "put on the new self, which is being renewed ... in the image of its Creator." What matters is that we do what he does, that is, that we give ourselves away in love. The opening prayers of today's Mass call God our "origin" and declare, "Our life is your gift." What we have received as a gift, we must give as a gift.

Jesus tells us today, judgment can come at any moment; our opportunity to be generous to others can cease at any moment. "To whom will all this piled-up wealth of yours go?"
